

Appendix 9.11 Important Local Views and Vistas





Arrow number:

- 1. Open vista facing south from Weston Village settlement boundary towards the former Weston Hall. This sharply defines the southern boundary of the settlement looking along the Wildlife Corridor bordering Basford Brook and separating Weston from Wychwood Park and Wychwood Village.**
- 2. Looking north west across the open buffer separating Weston Village from the proposed South Cheshire Growth Village. The Green Gap in this location needs to be extended to the Crewe to Derby Railway Line which provides a logical and firm physical boundary to the south of the proposed Growth Village.**
- 3. View from Snape Lane looking south towards Wychwood Village, signifying the distinctive rural setting of this development**
- 4. View N.E. from Snape Lane across one of the Wildlife Corridors towards Town House Wood.**
- 5. Looking in a S.E. direction from Wychwood Village across the Countryside Park which illustrates the integral relationship between the two elements.**
- 6. Open vista looking West from Wychwood Village showing extensive views across the Cheshire Plain**
