WESTON AND BASFORD NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN EXAMINATION

I would like to thank the Steering Group for the very swift response to my letter dated 21 July.

In that letter, I requested a map be provided showing the northern boundary of the Green Gap as defined in the Crewe and Nantwich Replacement Local Plan, as I considered that the boundary as shown on the Neighbourhood Plan Green Gap map near the words "South Cheshire Growth Village" was inaccurate.

The Steering Group's response indicates that the boundary on the Neighbourhood Plan is inaccurate, however, the map attached with your response appears to be the same as that in the Neighbourhood Plan. Therefore, I would appreciate a copy of the Map with the Green Gap boundary as shown on the adopted Borough of Crewe and Nantwich Replacement LP (2011 Proposals Map Urban Areas Inset). The Steering Group may wish to liaise with Cheshire East to ensure that the boundary used on the Map is correct.

I would be very grateful for a response to the above matter as soon as is convenient, albeit I do recognise we are now into the summer holiday period.

In the interests of transparency, may I prevail upon you to ensure a copy of this letter is placed on both the local authority and qualifying body's websites.
