

**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
CHESHIRE EAST BOROUGH COUNCIL
(WYCHWOOD VILLAGE AREA, CREWE)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING)
ORDER 2018**

Notice is hereby given that the Cheshire East Borough Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4, and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the 1984 Act") and all other enabling powers and in accordance with its duty under Section 122 of the 1984 Act.

1. The effect of the proposed Order will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting by vehicles at all times on all days on the following lengths and sides of Road;

Abbey Park Way, Crewe (both sides) – from a point 68 metres south west of its junction with Parklands Drive to a point 13 metres south east of said junction.

Abbey Park Way, Crewe (north and north west side)

- from a point 10 metres west of its junction with Maureen Campbell Drive for a distance of 72 metres in an easterly thence north easterly direction.
- from a point 10 metres south west of its junction with Golden Hill to a point 12 metres north east of said junction.
- from a point 25 metres south west of its junction with St Augustines Drive to its junction with Parklands Drive.

Abbey Park Way, Crewe (south and south east side)

- from a point 10 metres west of its junction with Maureen Campbell Drive to a point 10 metres east of said junction.
- from a point 10 metres south west of its junction with Chesterton Way to a point 10 metres north east of said junction.
- from a point 12 metres south west of its junction with Hillside Close to a point 10 metres north east of said junction.
- from its junction with St Augustines Drive for a distance of 17 metres in a south westerly direction.

Chesterton Way, Crewe (both sides) – from its junction with Abbey Park Way for a distance of 10 metres in a south easterly direction.

Delamere Close, Crewe (both sides) – from its junction with Parklands Drive for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

Golden Hill, Crewe (both sides)

- from its junction with Parklands Drive for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.
- from its junction with Abbey Park Way for a distance of 10 metres in a north westerly direction.

Heaton Way, Crewe (both sides) – from its junction with Parklands Drive for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

Hillside Close, Crewe (both sides) – from its junction with Abbey Park Way for a distance of 10 metres in a south easterly direction.

Maureen Campbell Drive, Crewe (both sides) – from its junction with Abbey Park Way for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

Parklands Drive, Crewe (both sides) – from its junction with Abbey Park Way for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

Parklands Drive, Crewe (west and south west side)

- from a point 10 metres south east of its junction with St Andrews Close to a point 12 metres north west of said junction.
- from a point 10 metres south of its junction with Pastures Drive to a point 10 metres north east of said junction.
- from its junction with St Augustines Drive for a distance of 40 metres in a north westerly direction.

Parklands Drive, Crewe (south side) – from a point 10 metres west of its junction with Golden Hill to a point 10 metres east of said junction.

Parklands Drive, Crewe (north side)

- from a point 10 metres west of its junction with Delamere Close to a point 10 metres east of said junction.
- from a point 10 metres west of its junction with Heaton Way to a point 10 metres east of said junction.

Parklands Drive, Crewe (north east side) – from its junction with St Augustines Drive for a distance of 20 metres in a north westerly direction.

Parklands Drive, Crewe (east and south east side) – from a point 12 metres north west of its junction with St Andrews Close for a distance of 63 metres in a north westerly thence north easterly direction.

Pastures Drive, Crewe (both sides) – from its junction with Parklands Drive for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction.

St Andrews Close, Crewe (both sides) – from its junction with Parklands Drive for a distance of 10 metres in a south westerly direction.

St Augustines Drive, Crewe (both sides) – from its junction with Parklands Drive for a distance of 23 metres in an easterly direction.
