2. ANNUAL REPORT OF THE PARISH COUNCIL

Councillor J Densem, Chairman of the Parish Council presented the Annual Report of the Parish Council.

The Chairman reported in detail the many achievements of the Council during the year and thanked all those who had made this possible.

The 40mph speed limit on Whites Lane to Basford was in force with the necessary signs and road markings in place.

The Basford bus shelter had been renovated and all of the Notice Boards had been brought up to a good standard.

The Parish Council had been in dealing with a range of issues affecting local residents and had liaised with the Borough Council and was grateful to Councillors Janet Clowes and John Hammond for their continued support.

The Vice-Chairman, Councillor J Cornell, spoke of the work of the Planning Committee. Planning issues continued to be of particular concern to the Parish Council and residents. Several meetings had been held with the Leader of the Borough Council and senior officers regarding the Local Plan and specific development proposals.

Mr Andrew Thomson had been engaged as Planning Consultant and would be representing the Parish Council at the Local Plan Examination in Public in the autumn

The HS2 proposals currently under discussion would have a marked effect on the Parish and were being closely monitored with representations being made as necessary.

Councillor J Chambers reported on the number of visits to the web-site totalling 1940 visits to 6030 pages.

The Resilience Plan, originally drawn up in 2011 had again been up-dated and would be circulated shortly.

The Chairman expressed thanks to all those who had contributed to the work of the Parish Council.
